### Safe Church Plan Compliance


- 1. It is very important to understand that we must have 2 people on deck at all times.

# POSTED PORT COMMUNITY CHURCH NURSERY GUIDELINES

As Per Safe Church Policy

- Only Nursery Caregivers and their assistants are to be in the nursery with the children for safety reasons.
- All Nursery Caregivers have been screened in accordance with the Safe Church Plan.
- All parents or guardians must complete a check-in sheet for their infant, toddler, or preschool child. This is to be completed once a year and updated as needed to ensure that their child is receiving the best possible care.

#### Diapers vs. Potty Trained

If your child is potty trained, the caregiver will assist child, but will do so with one foot in and one foot out of the open-door frame of the restroom. The child will not be visible to anyone within the room.

If a child is still in diapers, the parent or guardian will have to designate whether they want the care giver to change the diaper in an open-door restroom changing station or if they prefer to be contacted to change the diaper.

# **HELPFUL HINTS FOR NURSERY**

- 1. The nursery is for Infants Preschool.
- There is bottled water and animal cookies available for a small snack. Small cups and napkins are on the cabinet behind the door.
- 3. Remember that the children are to remain in the nursery. There are other ministries that are taking place in the fellowship area.
- 4. Everyone helps in cleaning up at 10:55AM.
- Gather the kiddos on the floor for a story time.
  There is also a binder with fun ways to talk about Jesus with these little ones.
